Frequently Asked Questions

I need a coat for myself or for members of my family. How do I participate?

Anyone can get a coat and no ID is required. Participants will be asked questions about demographics, household income, and food and housing security. Temperatures will be taken at the door and masks are required throughout the distribution site.

What items are accepted for donation?

Donations of new or gently used coats, hats, gloves, scarves, and snow pants are gratefully

accepted. Financial donations are welcome too!

Where do I bring donations?

Between September 14 and October 10, drop off any new or gently used coats, hats, gloves, scarves, and snow pants to any Klinke Cleaners in Dane County.

Can I volunteer to help?

Yes! We made sure that volunteering this year would be as safe and easy as possible. We have multiple options for volunteers to get involved with Koats for Kids.

We understand that different people have different levels of comfort, and have created opportunities to get involved before we open to the public, made roles that allow for extra
